### Bombay sapphire

Bombay Sapphire is marketed in a flat-sided, sapphire-coloured bottle that bears a picture of Queen Victoria on the label. The flavouring of the drink comes from a recipe of ten ingredients: almond, lemon peel, liquorice, juniper berries, orris root, angelica, coriander, cassia, cubeb, and grains of paradise.

### Tanqueray

Tanqueray is a London dry gin, reflecting its distillation process and origin in Bloomsbury, London. dry gin is made by double distilling grain, with select botanicals added during the second distillation.

### Ophir gin

Inspired by the Ancient Spice Route, Ophir is crafted using exotic hand-picked botanicals such as spicy Cubeb berries from Indonesia, Black Pepper from India and Coriander from Morocco. Bursts of citrus balance the rich, earthy aromas and soft spice of Ophir Oriental Spiced Gin.

### Hendricks gin

### Brockmans gin

The gin is third-party distilled in a copper still at G&J Distillery in Warrington, UK, and features blueberries and blackberries alongside traditional botanicals and citrus peels. Brockmans Gin is sweet, fruity and contemporary.

### Manchester raspberry gin

Manchester raspberry gin is a small batch gin created by a couple who met and live in the city. This is a delicate fruity take on our signature gin. Subtle, soft and perfectly balanced.
